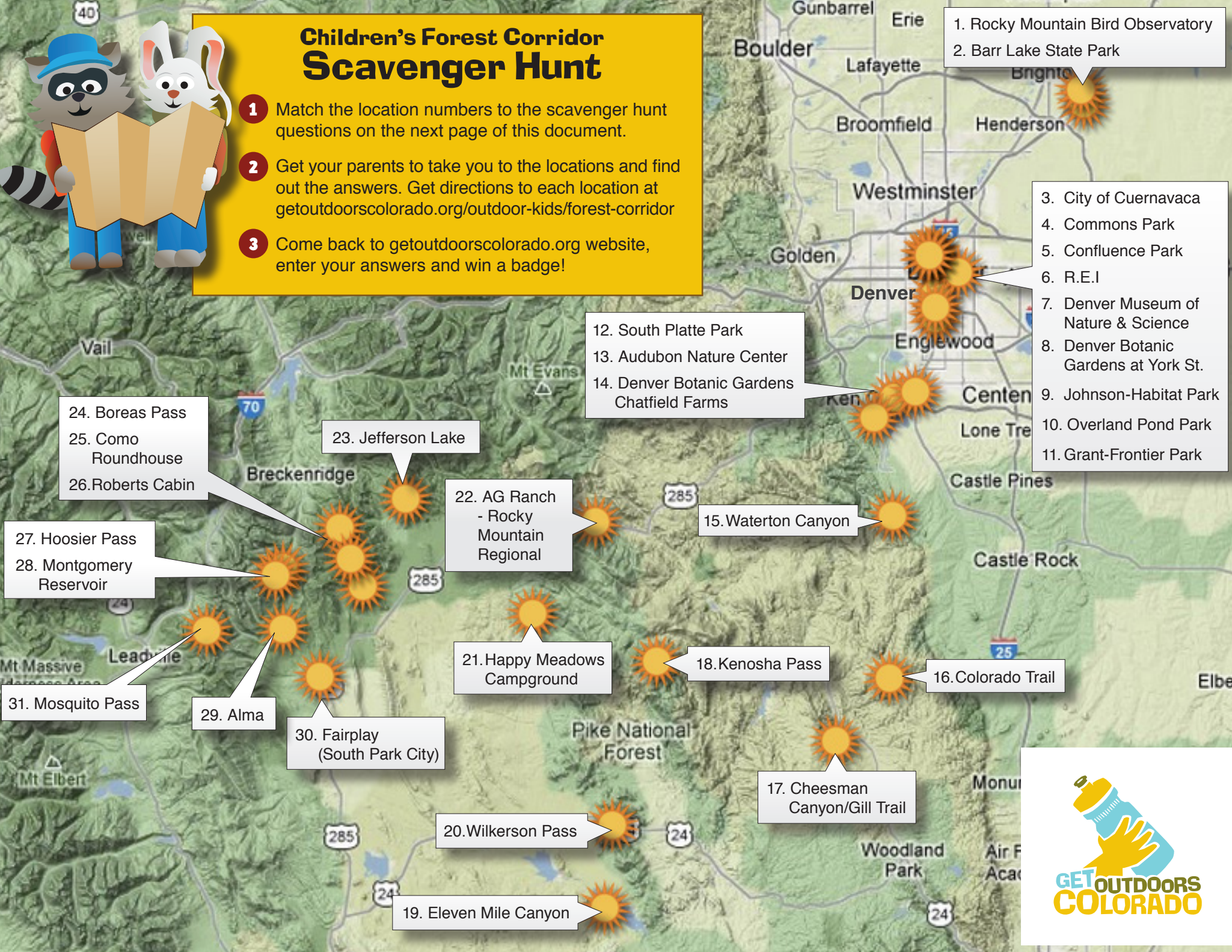


Children's Forest Corridor Scavenger Hunt

How To Make Your Map Look Like a Treasure Hunt Map

1. Print out the map.
2. Tear the edges off the page.
3. Wipe a wet tea bag over both sides of the page. The page will turn a light brown color. The page should be soaked through by the time you are finished.
4. Crumple it into a ball and let dry.
5. Gently open the map, and wipe both sides with cooking oil. Blot off the excess with paper towels.
6. Use additional items, such as dirt and charcoal, to “age” the paper even more.
7. Roll up the maps and place them in a decorated box or tube. Tie the map with ribbon or embroidery thread. Add trinkets to tie to the ribbon for an added effect, like fish beads and seashells.



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
